Sandro Petrone, is a senior correspondent and anchor for Rai, the Italian National Broadcasting Service. He works for the Second Channel news programme Tg2, which runs many editions from early morning to late night and some new analysis programmes and documentaries.

In nearly thirty years, Sandro Petrone has covered some of the most important international stories. From the Pope assassination attempt to the fall of Berlin Wall, from the Gulf War to other conflicts as the war in the former Yugoslavia, the Middle East crisis, the New York 9/11 and Madrid 3/11 attacks, the War in Iraq and Libia, Crisis in Tunisia and Libya. He was correspondent from the London, Paris and Moscow bureaus. He covers Us news since 1996, specially during presidential elections, war against terrorism and other special events.

He is professor of journalism and mass communication at the Rome “La Sapienza” University, Milan Iulm University and Italian Switzerland Courses of Journalism.

He wrote books about journalism and mass communications, won a prize with his songs anthology “Blues in Blu” and as composer he published the CD “Last call – a reporter’s notes”.
