

Curriculum Attilio Romita



Attilio Romita was born on August 1st in 1953 in Bari, where he got his BA in Law. He began his career as journalist for an independent radio station, Bari Radiouno, and then for an independent broadcasting, Telebari. His professional activity started at the “Puglia” newspaper.

From sport to politics, Romita stepped up from the local editorial office of the Italian Public Broadcasting (Rai) to the main radio news, Gr1, in 1990, directed by Luca Giurato and also Livio Zanetti. Later he became anchorman for the Tv evening news, Tg2, in 1995. During this period, he worked as the main editor covering all events concerning the Italian Prime Minister Berlusconi. In 2003 he moved to Tg1, the main Italian evening news, working always as an anchorman. Romita also presented a Tv program for Raiuno, “Sabato&Domenica Estate”, with Elisa Isoardi. Futhermore, he took part in several Tv programs, including “La Grande Notte” and “Artù”, with Gene Gnocchi. Attilio Romita is also an honorary sommelier from A.I.S., the Italian Sommelier Association, an honorary member of the Food Press Association and “Cavaliere del Barolo”. He received the Rodolfo Valentino Press Award and in 2010 the Journalist of the Year Award from the Accademia Italiana della Gastronomia Storica.
