

Curriculum Carlo Brienza



Carlo Brienza (born on 25th January 1953 in Bari, Italy) debuted on TV in 1979 as director of the first edition of the National TG3. Still engaged in his role as director and special correspondent for domestic politics, in March 1987 he became editor-in-chief. In 1989-90, he manages for Raitre the prime time programs "Specialmente sul Tre" and "Votapagina". In 1990, he was appointed deputy director and assistant president of RAI-TV for external relations. In 1991-93, Mr. Brienza was the author of monographs and special broadcasts from abroad for Raiuno and Raidue. At the same time, he serves as special envoy of TG2 for the program "Rubriche e Dossier". In December 1993, he was appointed deputy director of the Giornale Radio Unificato. Correspondent from London and the United Kingdom of Great Britain since 1996, in September 1998 he was appointed deputy director of Radiofonia. From 1998 to 2000 he works for Rai Sport, in charge of the coordination of the sport news blocks. Appointed deputy director of RAI International in 2000, he directed the television news production. In 2004, he debuts as commentator and special envoy of the "Grande Giostra del Gol", the program with the maximum audience on Rai International, which he manages and directs since the season 2005/2006. Mr. Carlo Brienza is the winner of the International Award for Journalism "Golden Dove for Peace".
